Dr. Steven Sanders – Fellowship-trained and an expert in joint replacement surgeries for the knee, hip and shoulder. Dr. Sanders is also a published author, including "The Journal of Bone and Joint Surgery." He has been honored in "Who's Who" and has been granted the Gerhard Kuntscher top orthopedic award. Apart from joint replacement, Dr. Sanders also has special interests in sports medicine, arthroscopy, visco-supplementation for arthritis of the knee and non-surgical regenerative options including stem cell treatments.

Dr. Yong Pak – Fellowship-trained as a pain management physician, Dr. Pak treats back pain, neck pain, sciatica, radiculopathy (cervical, lumbar, and thoracic), knee pain, hip pain and a wide variety of other conditions. He also does electromyographies and nerve conduction studies. Dr. Pak is well-versed in treatments such as epidural steroid injections and facet injections in the entire spine. Other procedures include sympathetic blocks, stellate ganglion blocks and botox injections.

Dr. John Milani – With a deep background in spinal surgeries, Dr. Milani is equipped to offer conservative and surgical treatment of all types of back and neck injuries and illnesses. Dr. Milani completed a fellowship in Spinal Cord Injuries and Spinal Pain at Dallas Rehabilitation Institute. Previously, he has served as Chief of Spinal Cord Injuries at Dallas Rehabilitation Institute and Healthsouth Medical Center.
